He led us through a series of exercises where we explored the micro choices that can lead to deeper connection and dignity for students or disconnection and shame. Jason's vignettes and prompts encouraged great conversation and consideration.

Happy, Thoughtful Kids Grown Here

This week, we had the privilege of welcoming Jason Craige Harris to Nantucket Lighthouse School. Jason spoke about the power of repair and how the skills of apologizing and taking responsibility are not often modeled or practiced in our broader culture.

Rupture is part of every parent-child relationship. We lose patience, fumble moments, and say things we wish we hadn't. These experiences don't define our parenting.

What matters most is repair. When we acknowledge our mistakes and apologize, we show our children the importance of accountability and that hard moments should be faced, not avoided. Repair with our children can be as simple as saying, "I didn't like how I spoke to you earlier. I'm sorry."

Jason's message was a helpful reminder that repair doesn't always come naturally, but it is one of the most powerful ways we can strengthen our relationships with our children.
